
Purpose Year 10 - 12

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Activity Library

Integrate SEL with everyday learning with the Wayfinder Activity Library.

- Activities range from 2–30 minutes for flexible integration into any class period.

Waypoints

Wayfinder's assessment tools track student growth in each of the CASEL-aligned core skill areas: Self-Awareness, Adaptability, Empathy, Collaboration, Agency and Purpose.

Summative Waypoints

- Contains 30 CASEL-aligned questions.
- Administer 2–3 times per year.
- Compare student progress against 6 Wayfinder Core Skills.
- Monitor completion rates across classes and schools

Formative Waypoints

- Short, weekly assessments enable consistent progress tracking.
- Educators and support staff can view skill progress by school or by class.
- Quickly see a student's top skill, most improved skill and area for growth.






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Wayfinder's core skills and competencies

The Wayfinder curriculum is built around six key competencies, each of which are aligned to the Collaborative for Academic, Social and Emotional Learning (CASEL).

The CASEL framework supports evidence-based SEL as an integral part of education from kindergarten through to high school.



Self-awareness Students understand themselves on different levels, from how they function to what nourishes and sustains them. *CASEL alignment: Self-awareness*

Adaptability Students willingly try again after making mistakes and comfortably navigate uncertainty with flexibility and openness. *CASEL alignment: Self-management*

Empathy Students attune to the feelings and needs of others and act to serve a common good. CASEL alignment: Relationship skills **Collaboration** Students actively build relationships, partner with others and facilitate belonging efforts across communities. *CASEL alignment: Social awareness*

Agency Students understand the value of their voices and work to support and advance their communities. *CASEL alignment: Responsible decision making*

Purpose Students deeply connect with their values to guide their decisions and interactions in the world. *CASEL alignment: n/a*
