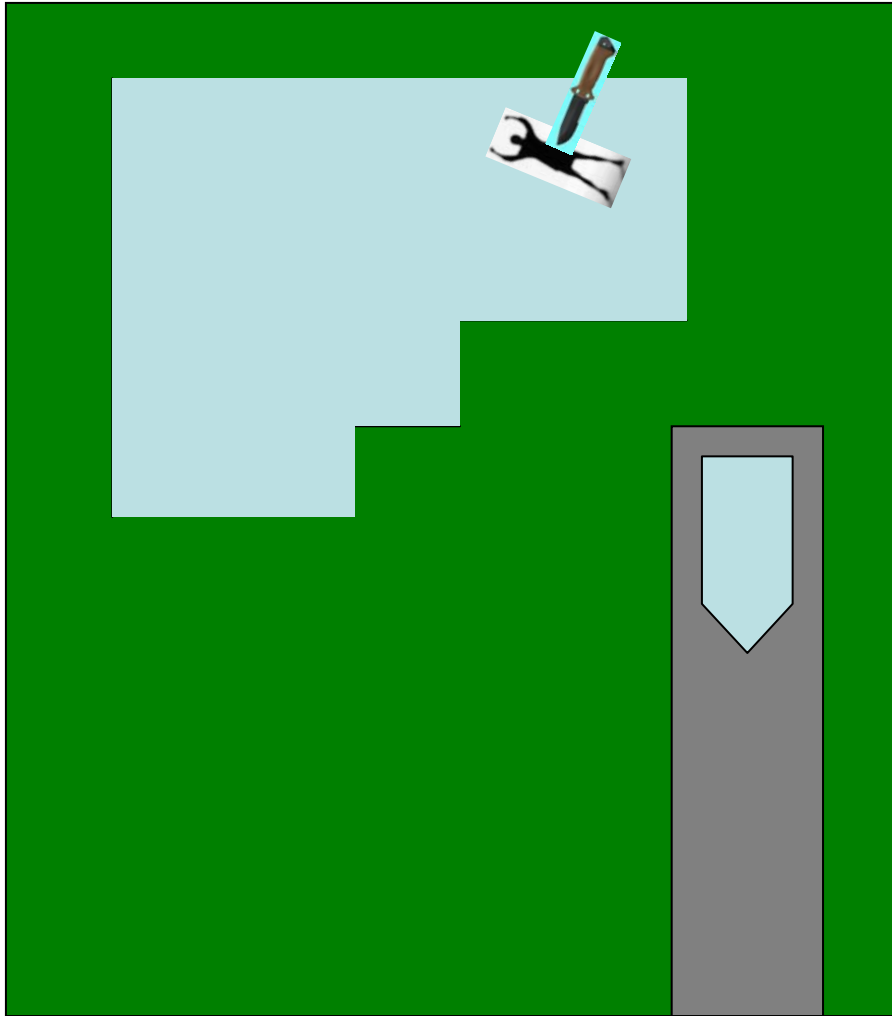


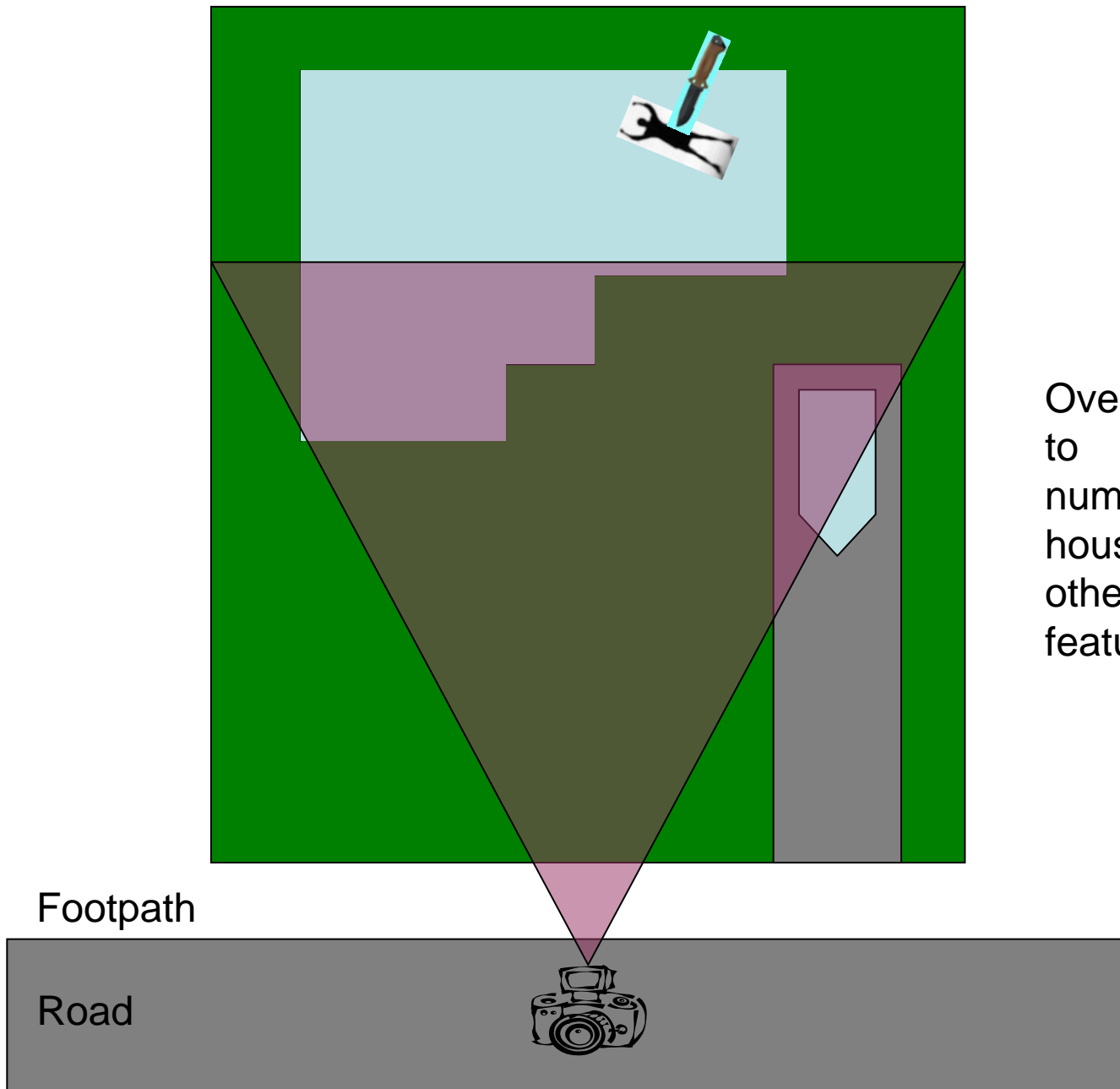
# Incident Scene Photography

- Detail or technical photo



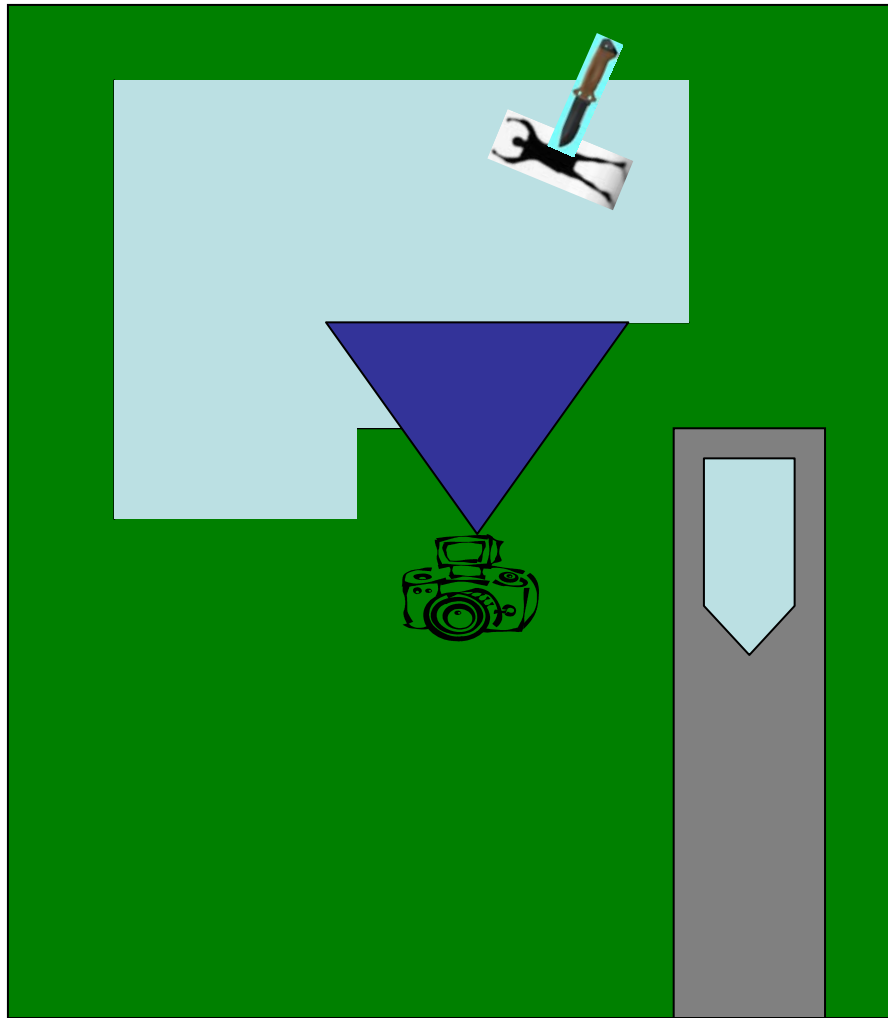
Footpath

Overview photo to include the number of the house or some other identifying feature

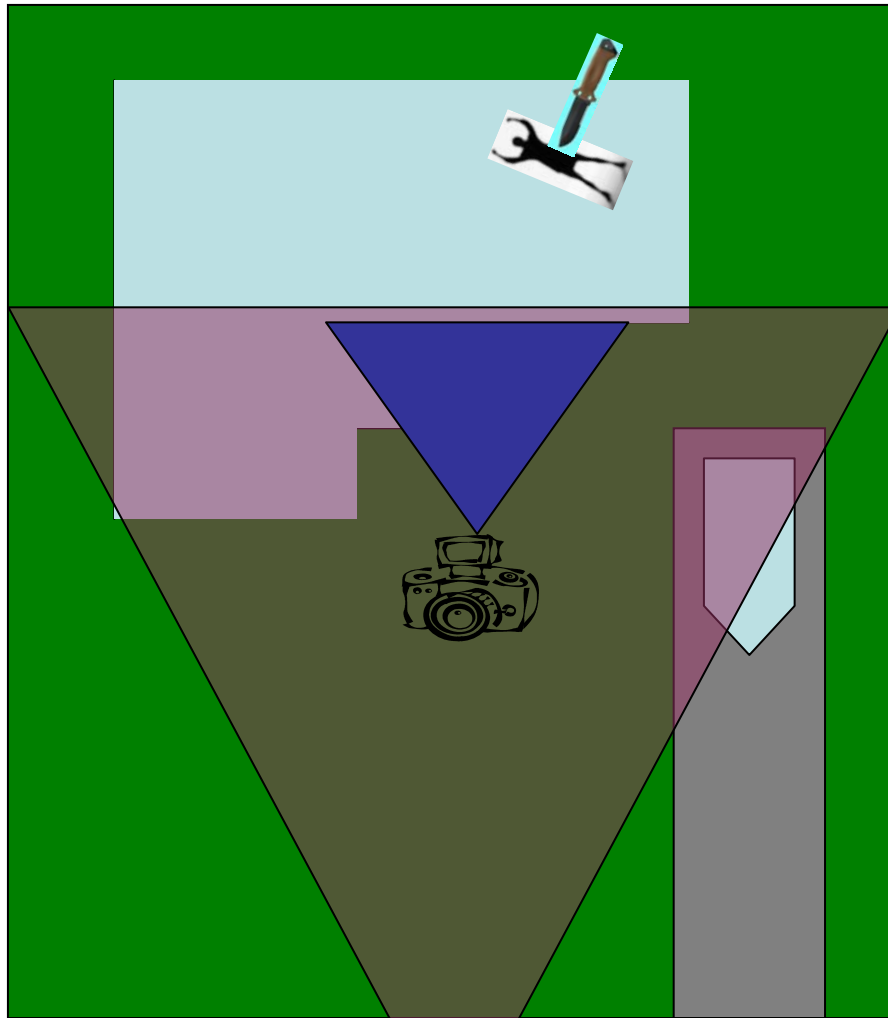
Take another photo closer to the building and nearer to the point of entry.

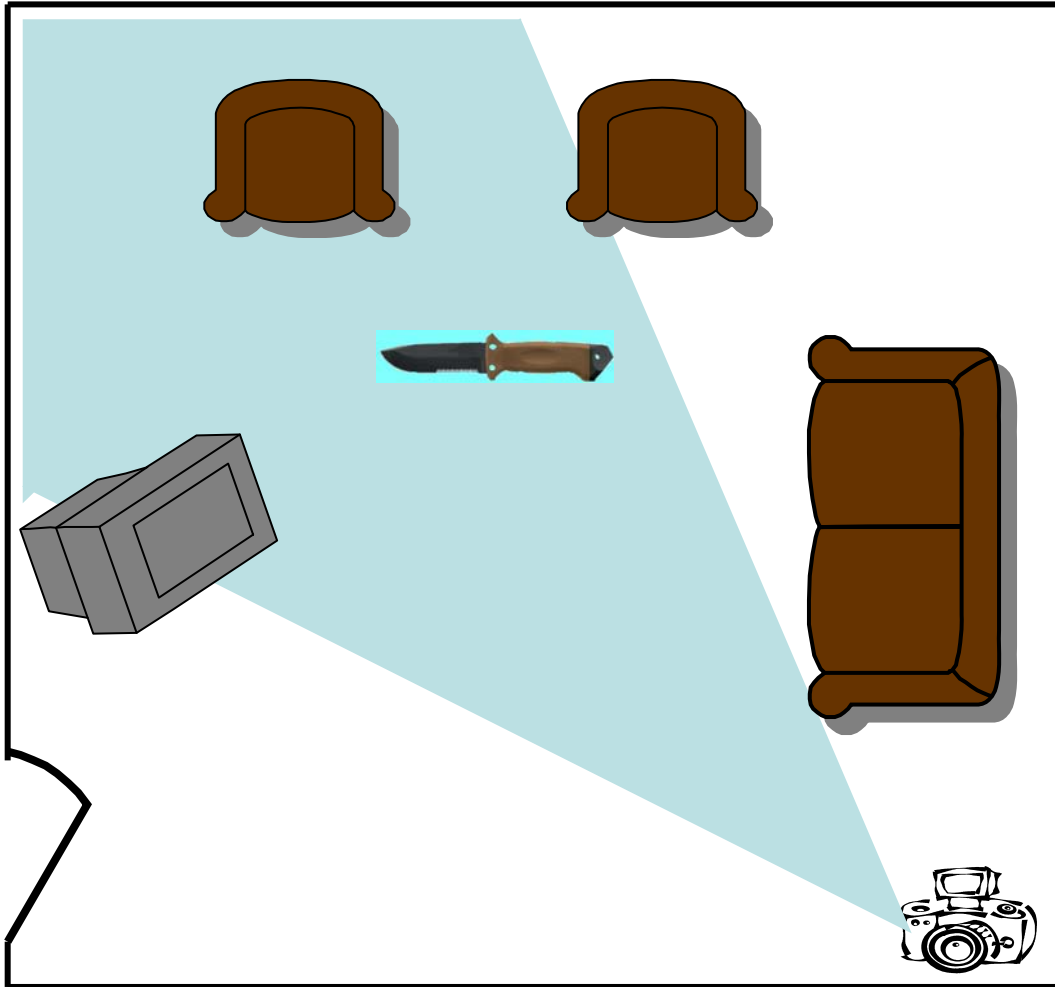


Overview photo to include the number of the house or some other identifying feature

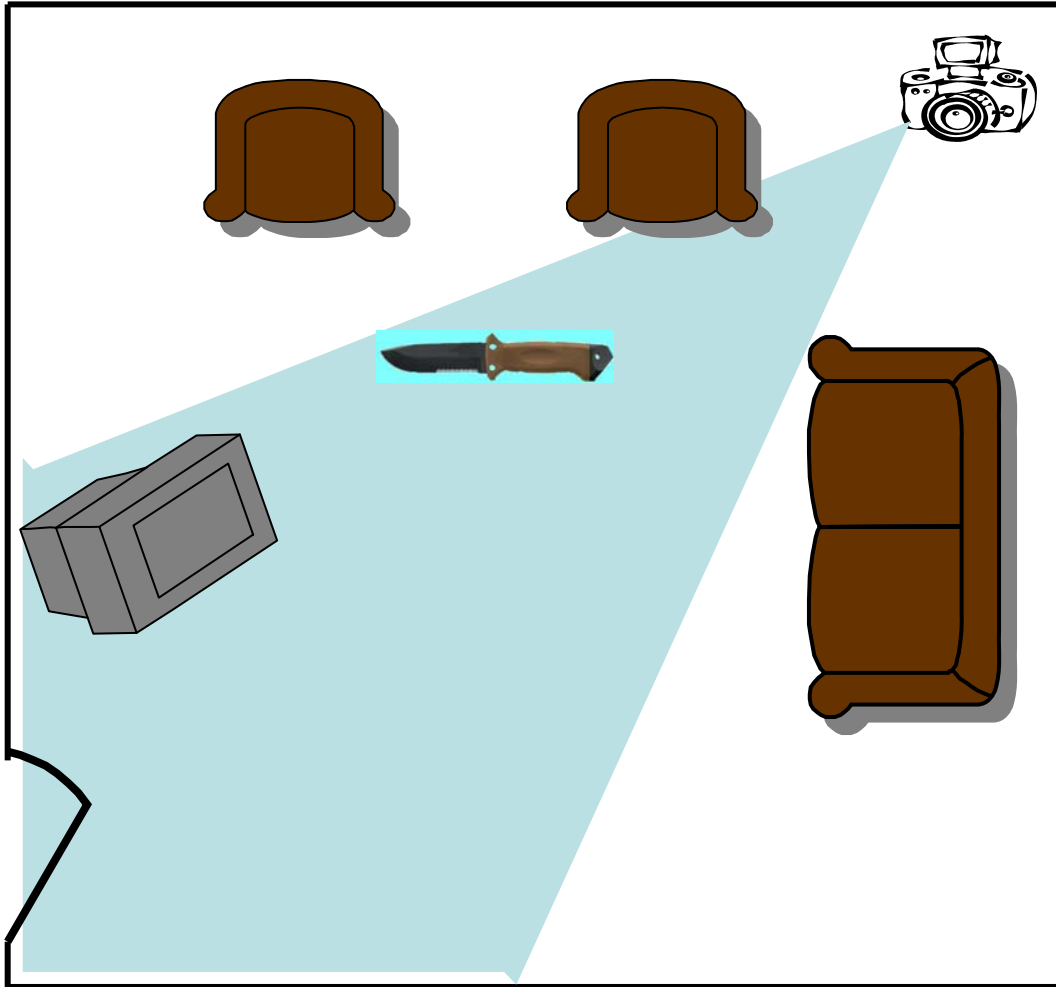

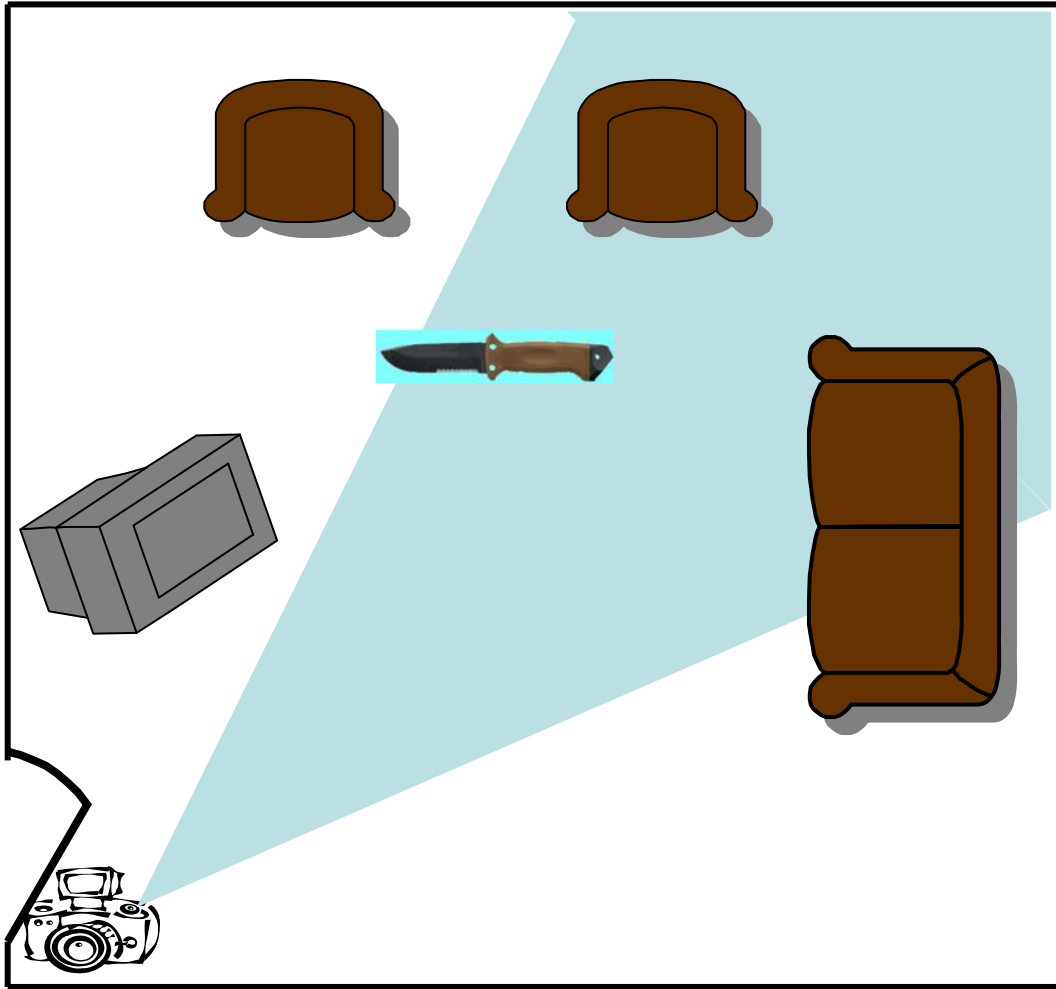




Overall photo to include overlap of objects common to following photos

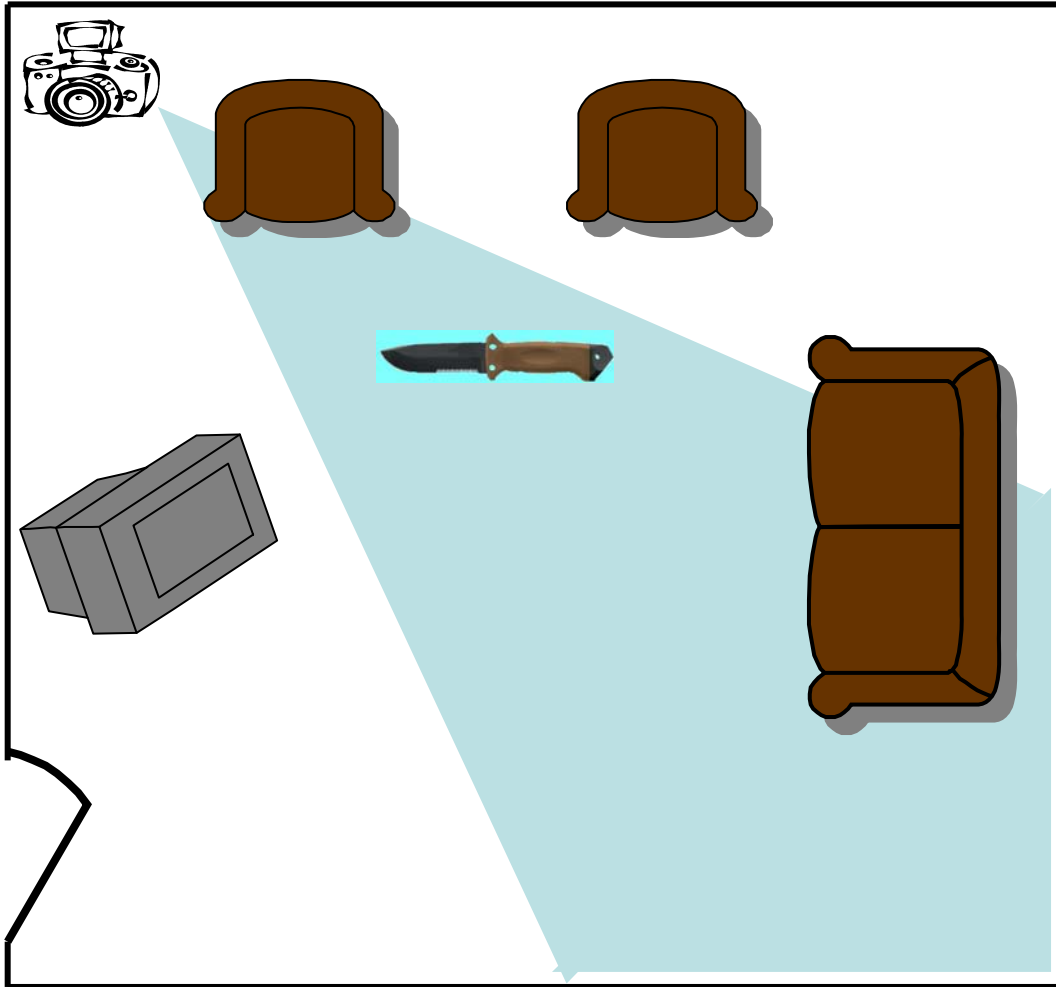
