"VITAL SIGNS" CHECKLIST

This checklist has been developed to assist you in ensuring you have considered some of the key Occupational Health & Safety risks associated with the implementation, maintenance and control of playground sites and equipment. Once this checklist has been completed, please refer to your Willis Risk Management contact for review and discussion (at nil charge).

A. DESIGN

1.	Is the equipment designed and built in accordance with the regulations and standards, i.e. AS4685:2014? E.g. impact absorbing surfaces, height of fall, guardrails, height of equipment, surfaces with grip etc.			
2.	Is equipment for older children separated from that for younger children?			
3.	Are swings separated from pathways and climbing structures?			
4.	Is there a safe entry and exit from the playground area?			
5.	Does the playground layout allow for good visual supervision? (clear line of sight?)			
6.	Have potential entrapment areas been eliminated?			
7.	Are play areas away from vehicle traffic and other hazards?			
8.	Are play areas reasonably protected from direct entry from unauthorised persons?			
9.	Do play areas have sufficent protection covering from the weather e.g. sun, wind, rain etc.			
10.	Are swings separated from general play areas?			

B. MAINTANANCE

11.	Does the school inspect, upgrade and maintain the playground regularly?			
12.	Are inspections documented and action items listed?			
13.	Are action items documented, followed up and completed in their designated time frame?			
14.	Is there a daily visual inspection carried out by a teacher on duty to assess the equipment and the possible hazards? For example foul play, dangerous objects, animal fouling, vandalism etc.			



15.	Are thorough monthly and annual inspections from experienced health and safety officers carried out in alignment with the standards and regulations?		
16.	If a piece of equipment is found to be faulty or unsafe, is there a process to ensure it is not used until the necessary repairs are made?		
17.	Are fixed sporting equipment assessed ad monitored? E.g.: football goal posts, basketball rings, soccer goals etc		
18.	Are mobile sports equipment stored safely? E.g.; sporting batts, balls etc		
19.	Are mobile sports equipment monitored and supervised?

21.	Have the playground safety rules been explained to the students and staff and implemented?			
22.	Is use of playground equipment supervised?			
23.	Is there a satisfactory supervision level to cover the play areas?
