Developing students' capacity to live and work as global citizens

Cathryn Berger Kaye's dynamic service-learning model has been incorporated into aspects of education programs throughout the world, most notably in schools offering the International Baccalaureate.

The program aims to build students' capacity to live and work as global citizens, giving them an opportunity to:

- enhance their intercultural capability
- become involved in a design thinking project
- develop their resilience and critical and creative thinking skills
- build new friendships.

The Young Entrepreneurs Program supports the learning outcomes for both the Victorian Curriculum and Australian Curriculum with a focus on service, skill development, student-initiated action and global engagement.

# Program structure

Victorian and overseas school teams will take part in 90-minute interactive online sessions every 2-3 weeks from mid-July 2022 to early-November 2022.

Students will:

- engage in meaningful online collaboration and use the design thinking framework
- participate in Cathryn Berger Kaye's engaging online sessions that focus on key global environmental issues such as global warming and climate change
- work closely with teams from other countries to solve problems and create solutions with the design thinking challenge.

## Audience

Year 9 students. Teams from each school will comprise 4 students and 1 teacher. Additional teams can potentially be added (if capacity allows).
